For very large machines, sound power level determinations are not required: only the emission sound pressure levels determined using Clause 6 of this and the other parts of ISO 9902. Very large machines are designated in the tables in ISO 9902-2 to ISO 9902-7 by the letter "L".

### Page 8, 12.1

Replace the first sentence of the first paragraph with the following:

For declaration purposes, the information on airborne noise emissions shall be given in the accompanying documents relating to the machine (see ISO 12100-2).

### Page 10, A.2

Delete the following text, including footnote 2, thus renumbering footnote 3 as footnote 2 and footnote 4 as footnote 3:

"Basic noise standard(s) used<sup>2)</sup>"

### Page 12, A.4

Replace the text in the fourth column, second row with the following:

"For terminology, see ISO 3744:1994, Clause 8 or ISO 3746:1995, Clause 8."
